02 Entry Requirements

1. Provide a notarized (English-translated) Year 12 Certificate in Australia (Senior High School Certificate) or an overseas equivalent qualification recognized by an accrediting authority.
2. Hold the Testamur and Records of Results of 10958NAT Certificate IV in Sinology Studies and 11127NAT Advanced Diploma of Buddhist Studies, or attend an online workshop and pass the academic and virtue assessments given by the Department of Sinology Studies.
3. Recommend completing the English Language Intensive Course for Overseas Students (ELICOS)*.

*Although the course is mainly taught in Mandarin, students need strong English skills, especially for the Sinology/Buddhist Studies related English unit NAT11128005 *Develop and apply complex English skills for Buddhist Studies*. Applicants from an English-speaking background and/or with sufficient English skills (reading, writing, listening and speaking) are exempt from ELICOS.
