02 Entry Requirements

1. Provide a notarized (English-translated) Year 12 Certificate in Australia (Senior High School Certificate) or an overseas equivalent qualification recognized by an accrediting authority.
2. Hold the Testamur and Records of Results of 10958NAT Certificate IV in Sinology Studies, or attend an online workshop and pass the academic and virtue assessments given by the Department of Sinology Studies.
3. Recommend completing the English Language Intensive Course for Overseas Students (ELICOS)*.
4. Attend an online workshop and pass the academic and virtue assessments given by the Department of Sinology Studies.

*Although the course is mainly taught in Mandarin, students need strong English skills, especially for the Sinology/Buddhist Studies related English unit NAT11126010 Develop and apply advanced English skills related to religious or philosophical contexts. Applicants from an English-speaking background and/or with sufficient English skills (reading, writing, listening and speaking) are exempt from ELICOS.

03 Mode of Delivery

- Face-to-face, on-campus delivery
- 20 hours per week consisting of lectures, supervised tutorials and projects, and online training/video/blended learning.
- International students **must** undertake full-time face-to-face study ONLY.
